Tax relief for donations.

Please note that for donations greater than €250 in a calendar year, the Revenue Commissioners will refund to the Foundation income tax relative to the donation. A **CHY2** form needs to be completed for this and may be obtained from our office.

For self assessed taxpayers, the donor can treat the donation as a tax deductible expense when calculating their tax bill. The Foundation does not reclaim in this case, and will issue a receipt to acknowledge that the donation tax was received.
